An electrical planner will be employed within the next three months. All critical equipment will have maintenance strategies developed within 12 months. Strategies for less-critical equipment will be developed within 24 months. A system for the upgrade and management of electrical drawings will be developed and implemented in the next 12 months.

A Preventive Maintenance Checklist - Grainger Industrial ...

A solid EPM program should include de-energized maintenance at least every three years on critical equipment, including the incoming electrical service from the utility. Cleaning, exercising, lubricating, relay testing and breaker testing are conducted during a de-energized state.
